FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Family and Friends of Grace UMC,

It's hard to believe that 2024 is almost over and we are waiting for the new year to begin. We often look forward to changes that we hope will occur in the new year and anticipate, sometimes with angst, that not all will be as we hope. This year we are hopeful for new opportunities for the use of our building. We are also hoping to find a new place to call home in a more central location where we hope to be able to better connect with our community.

We also often look back on the past year and find places of joy and sorrow, growth and learning. It's been a year of ups and downs. We've done a lot of work together and are in a place to continue to move forward as we seek to serve God and share God's love with all we meet.

As we get ready for this new year, we recognize that this past month or so has been very busy. Thanksgiving to Christmas brings so many opportunities to be with others, to celebrate, and to enjoy great food. But this time has also been very tiring. It requires a lot of energy to prepare for everything that we want to do and feel we are expected to do. So many are exhausted, hoping for an opportunity for some down time, but not knowing if it will come. There is so much that is expected from us – sometimes put on ourselves, but also by society that values output. We even fall into the trap of believing that we are only as good as the last thing we accomplished and are then expected to do even more. But this is NOT the way of God.

In an attempt to be counter-cultural and live into who we are as God's children, we will be using a four-week series in January called *Season of Rest.* It was co-developed with Upper New York, the Greater New Jersey and Eastern PA Conferences and Breakthough, which centers on the vital spiritual practice of rest, offering a time of renewal, balance, and inspiration. Throughout the four Sundays in January, we will *explore the profound importance of rest in our lives. We begin with Elijah's experience of divine rest, learn how to find a healthy balance of rest, work and play, understand the rhythm of rest modeled by God, and affirm that God has given everyone the gift of rest to be embraced.*

Week 1: Release into Rest (1 Kings 19:1-9)

Discover how God helps us release into rest rather than pushing us to do more.

Week 2: A Rhythm of Rest (Ecclesiastes 3:1-13)

Explore ways to cultivate a healthy rhythm of rest, work, and play for spiritual growth.

Week 3: Why Kind of Rest? (Genesis 2:1-3)

Embrace the natural rhythm of rest modeled by God.

Week 4: The Gift of Rest (Leviticus 25:1-19)

Celebrate rest as a gift for restoration, equity, and wholeness for all people.

I'm looking forward to going through this series with all of you, as we re-learn the rhythms of life as God would have us experience an abundant life. As we learn and practice, we may find the messages from the world hard to quiet. It is in these times that we can encourage each other to continue in our counter-cultural path as a disciple of Jesus and child of God, enabling us to continue to put our faith and love into action.
